Description

Parvocide 99 is a Veterinarian Type Disinfectant designed for use in veterinary clinics, animal hospitals, animal laboratories, animal life science laboratories, animal care facilities, kennels, tack shops, pet shops, zoos, pet animal quarters, stables, farms and pet grooming/breeding establishments. This product is a concentrated disinfectant and Virucide that will inactivate most notably Bordetella Bronchiseptica (causative agent of bacterial Kennel Cough) and Canine Parvovirus (CPV).

Directions for Use

DISINFECTION - For disinfecting, add 1 ounce of this product to one gallon of water. Apply this solution with a mop, cloth, sponge, hand pump trigger sprayer, or low pressure coarse sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow surfaces to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air dry.

Canine Parvovirus (CPV) Activity: At 4 ounces per gallon of water or equivalent dilution, this product inactivates Canine Parvovirus (CPV) on hard, non-porous, environmental surfaces in the presence of 5% blood serum with a 10 minute contact time.

BACTERICIDAL ACTIVITY: At 4 ounces per gallon or equivalent dilution rate (2812 ppm (mg/L) active quat), this product is effective against Bordetella Bronchiseptica (causative agent of Kennel Cough) **Mildewstat:** 1oz per gallon / **Deodorization:** 1oz per gallon / **Virucidal Activity:** 1oz per gallon
